## You are Immortal!

Did you know that you are immortal? You will live forever. Look at what C.S. Lewis says about humanity.

*There are no ordinary people. You have never talked to a mere mortal. Nations, cultures, arts, civilisations—these are mortal, and their life is to ours as the life of a gnat. But it is immortals whom we joke with, work with, marry, snub, and exploit—immortal horrors or everlasting splendours.*

Yes, human beings are immortal! Everything around us will come to an end, but we will live forever. You may ask, “How does this fit with Hebrews 9:27?”

**Hebrews 9:27** *And just as it is appointed for man to die once, and after that comes judgment, (ESV)*

Even this verse that says we will all die, tells us that after death, we are judged. Therefore, death for us is not the end of life, but the end of our time on earth. Look at what is said that will happen at the end of the world.

**Revelation 20:15** *And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire. (ESV)*

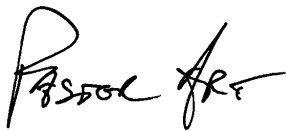
